

# 臺北城市科技大學外國學生獎助學金設置辦法

- 第1條 為鼓勵優秀外國學生入學並協助其在臺生活，進而增加本校國際化視野，訂定「臺北城市科技大學外國學生獎助學金設置辦法」(以下簡稱本辦法)。
- 第2條 本辦法所稱之外國學生，須為依據本校外國學生申請入學簡章申請就讀本校大學部之學生，且未具僑生身份或中華民國國籍，但不含交換留學生及各類專班之學生。
- 第3條 獎助學金項目與申請條件：
- 一、 新生入學助學金：每人補助新台幣23,000元整。  
憑最高學歷成績證明或原就讀大專校院之學業成績提出申請(將本校列為第一志願且經濟困難者優先錄取)。
  - 二、 新生生活服務助學金：新生入學第一學期每人申請上限新台幣7,000元整。  
申請期限：新生第一學期入學後1個月內提出申請。  
審核通過後需於當學期完成35小時學習服務，若當學期未完成不予發放。
  - 三、 勤學服務助學金：每人補助上限新台幣7,000元整。名額上限：每學期5名。  
前一學期缺、曠課時數(含曠課及事、病假)不得超過(含)25節，因重大疾病或意外事故請假者，不在此限。  
審核通過後需於當學期完成35小時學習服務，若當學期未完成不予發放。
  - 四、 華測成績優秀獎學金：大一起於當學期已完成註冊之學生，得檢附前一學期通過之華語文能力測驗最高級別成績證明及前一學期缺曠時數證明(曠課、事假、請本項獎學金。且同一級別限申請一次，已獲某一級別之獎學金者，日後僅得申請較前次更高級別之獎學金。金額如下：
    1. 大一生：B1、B2、C1 或 C2 級之成績證明，每人新臺幣2,000元整。
    2. 大二至大四生：B2、C1 或 C2 級之成績證明，每人新臺幣2,000元整。
- 第4條 凡符合申請資格之外國學生，須於註冊後備齊相關文件，向國際事務處提出申請，經國際事務處彙整後，提送獎助學金委員會審議。
- 第5條 獎助學金每學期發放一次，核發期間以大學部四年為限，不適用於延長修業年限者。
- 第6條 本項經費獎勵名額及審核方式經預算編列，依實際狀況執行。
- 第7條 本辦法經獎助學金委員會通過，陳請校長核定後公布實施，修正時亦同。

## REGULATIONS FOR SCHOLARSHIPS AND GRANTS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Revised at the 1st Scholarship and Grants Committee Meeting of the 1st Semester, Academic Year 2025 (August 11, 2025)

### Article 1

To encourage outstanding international students to enroll and to assist them in living in Taiwan, thereby enhancing the University's international outlook, the "Taipei City University of Science and Technology Regulations for Scholarships and Grants for International Students" (hereinafter referred to as "these Regulations") are hereby established.

### Article 2

The "international students" referred to in these Regulations are those who apply for admission to the University's undergraduate programs in accordance with the University's International Student Admission Guidelines, who do not hold Overseas Chinese student status or Republic of China (R.O.C.) nationality; however, this does not include exchange students or students enrolled in special program classes.

### Article 3 Scholarship and Grant Categories and Application Requirements:

- 1. Freshman Enrollment Grant:** Each recipient may receive a subsidy of NT\$23,000.  
Applications shall be submitted based on the applicant's highest academic transcript or academic records from their previous college/university. Priority will be given to applicants who list this University as their first choice and demonstrate financial need.
- 2. Freshman Living Service Grant:** Each freshman may apply for up to NT\$7,000 in their first semester of enrollment.  
Application period: within one month after enrollment in the first semester.  
Upon approval, recipients must complete 35 hours of learning service within the same semester. Failure to complete the required hours will result in no disbursement.
- 3. Diligence and Service Grant:**  
Each recipient may receive up to NT\$7,000.  
Quota: up to 5 recipients per semester.  
The total number of absences in the previous semester (including unexcused absences, personal leave, and sick leave) must not exceed 25 class periods (inclusive). This limitation does not apply in cases of major illness or accidents.  
Upon approval, recipients must complete 35 hours of learning service within the same semester. Failure to complete the required hours will result in no disbursement.
- 4. Outstanding TOCFL Performance Scholarship:**  
Starting from the first year, students who have completed registration in the current semester may apply by submitting proof of the highest level passed in the Test of Chinese as a Foreign Language (TOCFL) from the previous semester, along with a record of absences for that semester (including unexcused absences, personal leave, and sick leave).  
Each level may be applied for only once. Students who have already received a scholarship for a certain level may only apply for a higher-level scholarship thereafter.  
The scholarship amounts are as follows:
  - (1) First-year students:** NT\$2,000 per person for achieving B1, B2, C1, or C2 level.
  - (2) Second- to fourth-year students:** NT\$2,000 per person for achieving B2, C1, or C2 level.

### Article 4

International students who meet the eligibility requirements shall, after completing registration, prepare all required documents and submit their applications to the Office of International Affairs. The Office shall compile the applications and forward them to the Scholarship and Grants Committee for review.

### Article 5

Scholarships and grants shall be awarded once per semester. The award period is limited to a maximum of four years for undergraduate study and does not apply to students who extend their period of study.

### Article 6

The number of awards and the review procedures for these scholarships and grants shall be determined in accordance with the approved budget and implemented based on actual circumstances.

### Article 7

These Regulations shall be implemented upon approval by the Scholarship and Grants Committee and authorization by the President of the University. The same procedure shall apply to any amendments.
